





Violent and Criminal Incidents

- Texas statute (TEC 39.053) requires every district to publish an annual report that includes violent and criminal incidents at campuses in the district
- This piece of the report must include:
 - Number, rate and type of incidents
 - Information concerning school violence prevention and intervention policies and procedures used by the district
 - Findings that result from Safe and Drug-Free Schools and Communities Act
